




State Cannabis Tax Revenue from Retail Sales

2017 Total Retail Taxes \$655 Million






2020 Total Retail Taxes \$1.8 Billion



Cannabis Legalization Views














GROWTH IN CONCENTRATE AND PRE-ROLL

THE GROWING IMPERATIVE TO BE COMPLIANT


Average Compliance Scores by State*


